Dear Parishioners,

Pentecost marks the birthday of the Church as well as the conclusion of the Easter Season. It is hard to believe that 50 days have passed since the celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Pentecost is the day of the Holy Spirit, the day in which the promise of Jesus was fulfilled. That day when He left, the *Paraclete* would come upon them, the disciples, and that they would then do the things that Jesus did, and even greater things.

During the Easter Vigil celebration, the newly baptized and confirmed candidates were reminded that though the Catholic Church has many members, what we really need are more disciples. The job of a disciple is to WITNESS his or her faith in the whole world.

These disciples of Jesus were weak and broken. Among them were a traitor, a doubter, a coward, who would deny even knowing Him, two brothers who would quarrel over their rightful place and the rest who ran away after His execution.

Yet, when this day of Pentecost came and the Holy Spirit came to rest upon them, they became WITNESSES to the whole world of the power of their faith. They became MARTYRS, offering their lives in their zeal to spread the message of Christ, Crucified and Risen. The effect of the work of this most unlikely band of believers was to change the entire course of human history and the destiny of our Church.

This is what our Church needs today from its members ... to become disciples, witnesses, even martyrs. We do this by first becoming people of prayer, people of the Word, and people who really believe that the Holy Spirit has come upon them.

We all need to believe that we have been empowered to do the things that Jesus did and as He promised, even GREATER things than He did. We have been empowered by our baptism to speak the words of Jesus to the world, wherever we encounter it. Our Church will only fulfill the promise of Christ when we learn to believe that we are living in our own Pentecost and that we have been given the power of the Holy Spirit; that WE can make a difference!
